Shepherd's Corner Report from Malawi

Recently there have been some developments in our missionary work in Malawi we would like to tell you about. We regularly exchange emails with the eldership of the Tambala congregation that is overseeing the work we support in that area. The following is a recent exchange with them. (Orange = Decatur; Blue = Tambala)

I greet you dear brother in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, (Ndikukhulupira kuti muli bwino kwambiri, ifenso kuno tili bwino.)

We have woken up to a great news on what God has done through our brothers, brother Alex and brother Martin and brother Biswick. They were on a long to Nsanje district along the border of Malawi and Mozambique, this is a start we were hoping for and the results are above our expectations, they were at an area called Mphanga village in a traditional Authority Tengani, Nsanje district, they found about over 200 people gathered to hear the gospel, and amazingly out 200 people 86 people were baptized, what a story to share and we are told that on their way home they received a call that 56 more want to be baptized, they might return there again. So we will like to request if there might a possibility of Bibles, the way things are, we will need more Bibles for the growth of the new souls.

We usually do not always ask about this but it was so burdening to hear stories of hunger from that area, while there our brothers attended funeral of a young boy aged 9 who died of hunger, they said they have witnessed a hunger they have never seen in their entire life, people are eating unknown food (I will attach a photo of that) and they said this was not the only death of hunger but there have been so many in the past months, please keep us in your prayers and if you have the possibility of helping us please do so because our men would surely work well if they can reach out to people like that in both words and deeds.

We have absolute confidence in your eldership to us it where it is most needed. Maybe use some for Bibles, some for food or whatever. You are much closer to the situation than we are so we are trusting you to make those decisions. May God bless you & we will continue to pray. Keep us posted. We love you all.

We are all doing well here, we have waken up to a cold weather this morning, the rains have been coming for the past few days but it has come when the damage have been done and the crops cannot survive. We will try to plant the winter crops and we will be using the water pump to do the irrigation.

We are so thankful for the gift of \$3000 that you have sent to us, you cannot imagine how much help this will do to the people in our reach, firstly we bought food for families in the church who are starving and they received the food parcels last Sunday "I was so touched when one of the oldest woman in our church, Cheyabe knelt down and asked the church to join her in prayer for Decatur church, "today our families will have a proper meal because of Decatur Church's generosity, we pray that God will continue to bless them & their work.

Then our men in missions, Alex, Martin, Gift & Biswick went out to Nsanje district yesterday where they gave out over 200 bags of maize flour & 86 Bibles to the people that were baptized a week ago & those in dire need of food in this new church, we are really preaching the word in a way that is touching many lives, we are so grateful for your help & proud of our men in mission. On Sunday they will head to the same district of Nsanje where they will do another food distribution & have out more Bibles to the new church which was planted through a WBS student which brother Alex & Martin baptized last year, I will also give you an update on that as well.

We are so blessed! Let's do our best to help those that aren't!
