## THE RIGHT ATTITUDE TOWARD THE BIBLE

Purpose: To cause us to properly respect the Bible.

- I. All scripture is given by inspiration of God (II Timothy 3:16, 17; II Peter 1:21; I Corinthians 2:13; II Samuel 23:2).
  - A. Genesis 1 through Revelation 22 is inspired of God.
    - 1. Don't be taken in by the propaganda of the evolutionists and the humanists.
    - 2. Anything that contradicts the Bible is from the devil.
- II. God's word cannot be changed (John 10:35; Deuteronomy 4:2; 12:32; Proverbs 30:6; Revelation 22:18, 19; Galatians 1:8, 9: II John 9).
  - A. Examples of those who were rejected by God because they changed His word:
    - 1. Cain (Genesis 4:3-7; Hebrews 11:4).
    - 2. Nadab & Abihu (Leviticus 10:1, 2). See Numbers 16:46.
    - 3. Scribes and Pharisees (Matthew 15:9).
- III. The truth is all that will save (Joshua 24:14; John 8:32; I Peter 1:22; John 17:17).
  - A. Error must be recognized and rejected (Matthew 7:15; Mark 13:5; Acts 20:27-31).
    - 1. There is a big difference between the commandments of men and the commandments of God.
    - 2. We must never forget!
- IV. The New Testament is our guide for today (Romans 7:4-7; Colossians 2:14; Hebrews 7:12).
  - A. To "rightly divide the word of truth" (II Timothy 2:15); we must understand that the New Testament of Christ is our law today.
  - B. James said, "So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty" (James 2:12).

Conclusion: Paul said, "For we are not as many, which corrupt the word of God..." (II Corinthians 2:17). We must possess this same loyalty to the word of God.
