

Important Passages for Personal Evangelism

1. The right attitude toward the Bible – Deuteronomy 4:2; Deuteronomy 12:32; Proverbs 30:6; Revelation 22:18, 19; John 10:35; Galatians 1:8, 9; II John 9-11; Matthew 7:21-23.
2. We live under the law of Christ – **not the Law of Moses** – Colossians 2:14; Romans 7:1-7; II Corinthians 3:7-11; Hebrews 9:15-17.
3. The one church – Matthew 16:13-19; Ephesians 1:22, 23; Ephesians 4:4; Colossians 1:18; I Corinthians 12:13; Ephesians 2:16.
4. The beginning of the church – Acts 2:37-42, 47.
5. The plan of salvation – **Hear** – (Romans 10:17); **Believe** (Hebrews 11:6; Mark 16:16); **Repent** (Luke 13:3, 5; Acts 17:30); **Confess Christ** (Acts 8:37; Romans 10:9, 10); **Be baptized** (Acts 2:38; 22:16).
6. Baptism is a burial – Romans 6:3, 4; Colossians 2:12; John 3:23.
7. Worship in spirit and in truth – John 4:23, 24; Matthew 15:9.
8. Worship on Sunday, the first day of the week – **Lord's Supper** (Acts 20:7; I Corinthians 11:20; Matthew 26:17, 26-29; Acts 2:42); **Giving** (I Corinthians 16:1, 2); **Preaching** (Acts 20:7); **Praying** (I Thessalonians 5:17; Colossians 4:2); **Singing** (Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16).
9. The organization of the church – Philippians 1:1.
10. The qualifications of bishops and deacons – I Timothy 3:1-13; Titus 1:5-9; I Peter 5:1-4.
11. Elders, bishops, and pastors are descriptive terms that refer to the same men – Acts 20:17, 28; I Peter 5:1, 2; Titus 1:5, 7.
12. The role of women – I Timothy 2:11, 12; I Corinthians 14:34.
