"...THE STUFF LIFE IS MADE OF" Psalm 39:4; James 4:15; Matt. 6:34

INTRO:

- 1. We all know the statement, "how time flies."
- 2. Time "a nonspatial continuum in which events occur in apparently irreversible succession from the past through the present to the future."
- 3. "Time is the stuff life is made of."

I. HOW DO WE SPEND OUR TIME?

- A. Average life expectancy is 79 years so how do we spend those years?
- 1. To read the whole Bible in one year would take 12-15 minutes a day.
- 2. To read the Old Testament in a year would take 9-10 minutes a day.
- 3. To read the New Testament in a year would take only 3-5 minutes a day.

- A. How are we spending our time? 1 Tim. 3:15
- B. Do I realize our blessings? Psalm 23; Psalm 81:10; Joel 2:21-26
- C. Look around and tell me that things aren't better than they were two years ago.

- 1. I need to determine that I am going to do what I can to keep things going well and to get better.
- 2. Let's not spend, but invest our time in personal and congregational improvement.
