INTRO:

I. THE HIDDEN GOD.

- A. Moses and the encounter at Sinai. Ex. 33:18-23
 - 1. The beauty -- a desire to see God and to be known. vss. 18, 19
 - The tragedy -- the prohibition against seeing God's face.
- B. The same theme runs throughout the Old Testament.
 - 1. The beauty -- David. Psalm 27:4, 7-9a
 - The tragedy -- penalty associated with seeing God's face.
- C. The knowledge most Old Testament characters had of God was secondary.

II. GOD BECAME FLESH.

- A. 1600 years after Moses another man took up this theme with a difference.
- B. The witness. John 1:1-5, 14-18; 1 John 1:1-3a.
- C. This is not John's interpretation, but Jesus himself claimed he had come to show us the father.

III. THE ILLUSTRATED MAN.

- A. Man was made to be like God. Gen. 1:26, 27
- B. Man perverted the image with the fall.
- C. Christ is the perfect man and the perfecter of men.
