

# Evening Lesson

## MIDDLE 'C'

Heb. 13:8

### INTRO:

1. Illus: Middle 'C'
2. Christ is the note by which we get our lives in tune with God!

### I. WHAT CAUSES US TO BE OUT OF TUNE IS WHAT THE BIBLE CALLS SIN.

- A. Sin separates us from God (**Isaiah 59:1, 2**) and from life's true purpose.
- B. Sin seeks to dominate our lives (**Romans 6:16**), and unless it is remedied, will bring about our eternal destruction (**Matthew 7:13-14**).

### II. CHRIST MAKES IT POSSIBLE FOR US TO GET OUR LIVES IN TUNE.

- A. He died on the cross, paying the price for our sins so that we might have forgiveness of sin. **Eph. 1:7**
- B. God will forgive those who believe in Jesus (**Acts 16:31**), repent of their sins (**Acts 17:30-31**), confess Jesus (**Rom. 10:9-10**), and are baptized into Christ for the forgiveness of sins (**Acts 2:38; Gal. 3:27**).
- C. God will continue to keep in tune (forgive) those who continue to follow the "sheet music" of His Word.  
**1 John 1:7**
- D. Christ enables us to be in tune with God, one another, and ourselves.

### III. CHRIST IS TO BE THE CENTER OF OUR LIVES OR MIDDLE C.

- A. He was middle C yesterday; He will be middle C tomorrow; He will be middle C a thousand years from now.
- B. The world outside sings flat, sin causes us to be out of tune, but my friend, Christ is Middle C.
- C. Only he can bring us into harmony with God's will.
