SERMON: 12 Hours to Live!

TEXT: Luke 12:16-21

Intro: In verses 17-19, the word "I" appears six times, showing the selfish focus this man had as a result of his fortune. His plan was to store his abundant resources for himself, as though the assets were his alone and should be hoarded. This focus on self was what Jesus condemned. Thus, the parable ends with the announcement: "*Fool! This night your soul will be required of you*" (Luke 12:20). With only hours to live, what would he do? **What would I do?**
