INTRO:

- 1. In the musical RENT there is a song that reminds the listeners that there are 525,600 minutes in each year.
- 2. Those lyrics can remind us of another song that we sometimes sing in our assemblies.
- 3. That song asks a very important question: "How are we using God's golden moments?"

- A. In about 20 of those minutes I could have stopped by the hospital to visit and pray with a fellow Christian recovering from surgery or some ailment.
- B. In about 5 of those minutes I could have graded a World Bible School lesson and put it in an envelope to return to someone somewhere in this world.
- C. In 365 of those minutes I could have said a prayer with my child every single night of the year.
- D. In 1 of those minutes I could have texted or emailed someone that visited our services.
- E. In 30 of those minutes I could have visited a widow and enjoyed a glass of tea or lemonade.
- F. In 520 of those minutes I could have had a five-minute devotional with my family twice a week.

II. TIME IS PRECIOUS.

- A. "Lost wealth may be replaced by industry, lost knowledge by study, lost health by temperance, but lost time is gone forever."
- B. "For yesterday is but a dream and tomorrow is only a vision; but today, well lived, makes every yesterday a dream of happiness and every tomorrow a vision of hope."
